3/16" Acrylic or Polycarbonate
(based on material availability)

20" W x 20" H x 16" D
4" diameter access holes

Cleaning Instructions: The enclosure should be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected after each use. Acrylic and polycarbonate can be cleaned with Bleach – household grade; Isopropyl Alcohol, diluted with water to 30% strength; or Hydrogen Peroxide – pharmacy grade. This cleaning will degrade the product and after a limited number of uses the product will have to be cleaned and disinfected and disposed of as medical waste, and replaced.

Inspections: The Custom Intubation Enclosure must be closely inspected at regular intervals, and before and after each use for wear, cracks, broken seals, and its continued ability to perform its stated function. If your enclosure does not pass the above inspection, remove it from service and destroy it.

WARNING The Custom Intubation Enclosure provides a temporary barrier between medical personnel and patient but is not rated to stop the spread of infectious disease and will not prevent infectious disease, virus, or germs from exiting the enclosure. It is the sole responsibility of purchaser and medical staff to disinfect between uses and to minimize the spread of any infectious disease when using the equipment.
